

STATEWIDE TEEN ART MENTOR PROGRAM (STAMP) GUIDELINES

1. The STAMP program is open to teens 13-19 years of age. To establish eligibility, calculate your age as of July 19, 2019. You must be mentored by a WRAA member or HS exhibit sponsoring art club, exhibit coordinator or art teacher.
2. All artwork must be ORIGINAL in concept and design. It must have been done by the entrant. Copies of other artworks, copyrighted photographs cannot be accepted. No decorated kits are acceptable. Work must have been completed within the last two years.
3. Enter one work in suggested media: Painting: Oil, acrylic, or watercolor Crafts: Clay, wood, metal, fiber, paper Graphics: Drawing, prints, pastel Photography: Photograph B&W, color or Sculpture: Any material, mixed- digital print media.
4. There are two ways to become eligible to have STAMP artwork shown at the Annual State Conference Exhibit. In either case, a teen can show only one piece. (1) A teen's work may be selected by the juror at a WRAA sponsored regional HS exhibit. (2) A teen may be selected and mentored by a WRAA member if the mentor pays a \$20 registration fee. Checks are made payable to WRAA.
5. The deadline for registration is Friday, July 19, 2019. Registration will make the teen eligible to exhibit in August and September at the Pyle Center on the UW-Madison Campus, to become eligible for cash awards, and to attend a teen recognition and awards ceremony at WRAA's annual "Evening with the Arts" reception and celebration.
6. The registration form must be complete and Parent/guardian signatures and contact information are required. Registration includes the entrant's attendance to the Evening with the Arts reception on Friday, September 20, 2019 at the Pyle Center.
7. The artist may bring guests to the reception for a fee of \$10 per guest. Registration form for this event can be downloaded at wraawrap.com/activities and must be completed for both artist and guests.
8. All STAMP works will be published in the 2019 WRAA color exhibit catalog.
9. WRAA STAMP Awards: First: \$125, Second \$100, Third \$75. Other individual or group awards may be available as funding varies from year to year.
10. Artwork due at the Pyle Center, 702 Langdon St., Madison, WI, Friday, August 2, 11 am-1pm or Saturday, August 3, 11am-1pm.
11. All paintings, graphics and photographs must be dry, framed and ready to hang (including wires side-to-side on the back). No tension devices will be accepted. Unframed canvas works are acceptable if edges are painted. THE PYLE CENTER AND THE EXHIBIT SPONSORS ARE NOT RESPONSIBLE FOR DAMAGE, THEFT OR LOSS OF YOUR WORK. You must provide your own insurance if desired.
12. Fill out and attach the identification label to the back of your artwork.
13. Pick up your artwork after the awards ceremony on Friday, September 20, 2019 at Evening with the Arts.

EXHIBITION DATES: Monday, August 12 - Friday, September 20, 2019, Pyle Center

STAMP JUDGING: Friday, August 16, 2019 - Award recipients will be notified.

EVENING WITH THE ARTS REGISTRATION/FEE FORM: Form must be completed for the STAMP participant and guests. Due September 1, 2019, Mail to the address on the form. Download form at wraawrap.com/activities

AWARDS/RECEPTION: Friday, September 20, 2019 - WRAA's Evening with the Arts, Pyle Center, 6 - 9pm. Awards, start at 7:15 pm.
